

# Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, founded in 2010 by American Express, **Small Business Saturday** was established to support small businesses across the United States of America and is celebrated annually on the Saturday following Thanksgiving; and

**WHEREAS**, falling between Black Friday and Cyber Monday, well-known high volume shopping days, Small Business Saturday is a day to support local small businesses that create jobs, boost the economy, and help to preserve neighborhoods around the country, and it is a way for consumers to demonstrate their commitment to the locally owned, independent businesses in their community; and

**WHEREAS**, according to the United States Small Business Administration, there are currently 32.5 million small businesses in the United States, representing 99.7 percent of all firms with paid employees in our nation, and they are responsible for generating 62 percent of net new jobs created since 1995, and 79 percent of consumers understand the importance of supporting small businesses in their community on Small Business Saturday; and

**WHEREAS**, the Small Business Saturday Coalition was founded in 2011, and it along with other advocacy groups, coalitions, and public and private organizations across the United States have endorsed the Saturday after Thanksgiving as Small Business Saturday, and it has become a nation-wide, well-known event, with a majority of consumers supporting the initiative and participated in spending billions of dollars with independent merchants, and they discover the day encourages them to continue shopping and eating in the establishments throughout the year, and during the challenges of the pandemic, it is especially vital that small businesses be supported by us all; and
