WHEREAS, the City of Tampa, Florida, along with many cities across the United States of America, are encouraging its citizens to explore the wide range of recreational activities available to them, especially through the Parks and Recreation Department, where a variety of fun and exercise can be enjoyed by the entire family; and

WHEREAS, hundreds of cities across the country, including Tampa, have pledged to support programs such as National Park Trust's **Kids to Parks Day** to get more kids to parks, promote healthier lifestyles, and to help facilitate raising a healthier generation of children; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa is recognizing National Kids to Parks Day to help encourage children's appreciation for the outdoors and recreational activity, and to promote the abundance of activities in our community, and its Parks & Recreation Department and the Tampa Police Department are hosting the **Annual Kids to Parks Day** at Copeland and MacFarlane Parks on Saturday, May 20, 2023, featuring fun games, activities, a rodeo, and more.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jane Castor, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the city of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim Saturday, May 20, 2023, as
