WHEREAS, all Berkeley Prep students participate in community initiatives throughout the year, and along with a balanced curriculum of academics and activities, the students play exceptional competitive sports, with 80 percent of them playing at least one sport, and the school is a member of the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA); and

WHEREAS, the Berkeley Prep Varsity Football Buccaneers, led by its beloved coach of the past 17 years, Dominick Ciao, along with his dedicated staff, captured the school's first *FHSAA Class 2M State Football Championship* title when the skilled and focused team upset the previously unbeaten Miami Norland Vikings with a 28-20 victory, held at Bragg Memorial Stadium at Florida A&M University on Saturday, December 9, 2023, which culminated a season of dedication, commitment, and extraordinary efforts by each team member and the coaches.
