WHEREAS, over 200 businesses and community organizations have come together to create the GaYBOR District Coalition in Historic Ybor City for the mutual benefit of all GLBT friendly businesses in our great city, and

WHEREAS, the GaYBOR District Coalition celebrates the diversity of our community and promotes and provides a safe, tolerant, and welcoming focal point for the GLBT community from around the Tampa Bay region and the state; and

WHEREAS, the GaYBOR District Coalition is now recognized by national GLBT media as one of the top destinations in the \$65 billion a year GLBT travel industry; and

WHEREAS, the GaYBOR District Coalition will hold its fourth annual GaYBOR Days Celebration on June 30 through July 4, 2011 in honor of the Stonewall Rebellion and in celebration of the diversity in our great city; and

WHEREAS, as part of its commitment to continued social progress and the cause of human rights, the City of Tampa is pleased to recognize the prominent place in our community held by the GaYBOR District in Historic Ybor City.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tampa, Florida do resolve that, in honor of the 43rd Anniversary of the Stonewall Rebellion, June 30 through July 4, 2011 is hereby proclaimed in recognition of the
