WHEREAS, as skilled professionals, surgical technologists are entrusted with the lives and well-being of patients, and are responsible for the application of sterile and aseptic techniques in the operating room, making sure the equipment functions properly, and facilitating safe and effective performance during invasive surgical procedures; and

WHEREAS, surgical technologists strive to prevent life-threatening surgical site infections and maximize patient safety, and their motto "Aeger Primo, The Patient First" reflects total commitment to patient safety and advocacy.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim September 18-24, 2011 as
