WHEREAS, University Village, a Tampa, Florida retirement community shares a deep commitment to an "age-friendly" environment that empowers older persons to continue their lives fully engaged physically, intellectually, spiritually, and socially; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the celebration of International Day of Older Persons, University Village will honor residents, seniors and guests with special events and activities from September 27-30, 2011 that will showcase successful ageing through positive relationships, making healthy choices, learning new skills, beginning new hobbies, serving as advocates and volunteering in the community, and setting individual goals that defy the stereotypes of ageing.
