WHEREAS, on October 8, 2011 the brave teams will receive their boarding passes and will launch their flying machines 30 feet above the Seddon Channel adjacent to the Tampa Convention Center in Tampa, Florida and attempt to successfully fly their homemade crafts across the bay.
