WHEREAS, the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center was established in January 2003 to provide a collaborative mechanism to help states and local governments enhance cyber security; and the City of Tampa Technology and Innovation Information Security Office provides a comprehensive approach to help enhance the security of this government; and

WHEREAS, maintaining the security of cyberspace is a shared responsibility in which each of us has a critical role, and awareness of computer security essentials will improve the security of the City of Tampa information infrastructure and economy; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (www.us-cert.gov), Multi-State and Analysis Center (www.msisac.org), National Cyber Security Information Sharing (www.staysafeonline.org) and National Association of State Chief Information Officers (www.nascio.org) have declared October as National Cyber Security Awareness Month, and all citizens are encouraged to visit these sites to learn about cyber security and put that knowledge into practice in their homes, schools, workplaces, and businesses.

Now, therefore, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim the month of October 2012 as

CYBER SECURITY AWARENESS MONTH
