WHEREAS, stress is recognized as a major risk factor in disease, and massage therapy is regarded as a premier strategy for effective stress management; and

WHEREAS, increased awareness of the benefits of massage therapy contributes to the health and vitality of the residents of our community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim October 21-27, 2012 as
