WHEREAS, Prodigy is an early prevention, intervention and diversion community program designed to improve the opportunities of at-risk children and operates in seven counties in West Central Florida and its purpose is *Transforming Young Lives*; and

WHEREAS, Prodigy utilizes visual and performing arts as a way to reach youth, 7 to 17 years of age, who live in high risk neighborhoods or who have been diverted or adjudicated from the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, Prodigy teaches core self-regulation skills such as anger management, problem solving and communication, and through its programming that include behavior based curriculum, manuals, lesson plans and performance measures, youth demonstrate improvement in behavior control, affective responsiveness, and academic self-efficacy; and

WHEREAS, with a program completion rate of 85 percent and a non-relapse rate of 89 percent, Prodigy has shown positive progress in youth behavior, and is seen as a model for diversion programming by leading national practitioners and researchers; and

WHEREAS, throughout the month of February children from all over Central Florida will be participating in the Annual Prodigy Cultural Arts Program Showcases, giving them the opportunity to spotlight their visual and performing arts talents.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim February 2013 as
