**WHEREAS**, the impact of the United States Department of Labor reaches beyond the workplace, touching people's lives at all stages by allowing employees to take leave to tend to loved ones, provide training for veterans and young people, and guaranteeing the pensions of retired workers; and

**WHEREAS**, the organization continues to evolve to accommodate the altering needs of the American worker by partnering with employers, community organizations and institutions of higher learning to improve job training, provide lifelong learning opportunities and advancement efforts for profitable employment; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Labor has been of inestimable value for the past century, and it will remain of paramount importance to the well-being of all Americans in the future, addressing tomorrow's conditions and meeting the needs of future workers with the same insight, foresight and commitment it has always demonstrated.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim March 4, 2013 as
