**WHEREAS**, established in 1982, the George Edgecomb Bar Association is Tampa, Florida's largest predominately African American voluntary bar association; and

**WHEREAS**, the association is named for the late Honorable George E. Edgecomb, a native of West Tampa, and Hillsborough County's first African American judge, for which the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Courthouse was dedicated, and first African American Chief Assistant County Solicitor and Assistant State Attorney; and

**WHEREAS**, the 100 members of the George Edgecomb Bar Association strive to maintain the ideals and principles The Honorable George Edgecomb embodied during his lifetime, and are dedicated to the promotion and recognition of minorities within the legal profession and the judiciary, and following in his legacy of community leadership they are committed to increasing the legal profession's involvement in community affairs and public service; and

**WHEREAS**, annually since 1983 the George Edgecomb Bar Association has awarded scholarships to deserving Hillsborough County Public School's graduating African American seniors, and has provided a Florida Four-year Prepaid College Tuition scholarship for a ninth grade African American student; and

**WHEREAS**, the George Edgecomb Bar Association's 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Scholarship Banquet will be held on Monday, April 29, 2013 at the Hilton Tampa Downtown Hotel.
