WHEREAS, Dr. Allan L. Goldman, M.D., graduated from the University of Minnesota Medical School, Minneapolis, Minnesota, in 1968, and completed his Fellowship in Pulmonary Disease from Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington, D.C. in 1972, and was later discharged as a Major from the United States Army Medical Corp; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Goldman has been a dedicated member of the University of South Florida (USF), Morsani College of Medicine, Department of Internal Medicine since 1974 when he began his tenure as Assistant Professor of Medicine, and thereafter appointed Professor and Chairman of Internal Medicine in 1992 and served as Chairman of the Graduate Medical Education Committee of Medicine, and he was the Founding Leader of the USF College of Medicine Faculty Council; and

WHEREAS, dedicated to his profession, Dr. Goldman has served in leadership capacities with many organizations including the Florida Lung Association, Florida Thoracic Society, USF College of Medicine Research Committee, USF Cancer Hospital Development Planning Committee, Tampa General Hospital Bylaws Committee, and currently serves on the USF College of Medicine Executive Council, Florida Hospital Tampa Emeritus Staff, Hillsborough County Medical Association Foundation Board, and the Association of Professors of Medicine Education Committee, among many others, and included in his numerous honors he has been named a Fellow of the American College of Physicians, listed in the Best Doctors in America, America's Top Doctors, Who's Who in Medicine and Healthcare, and was presented the Outstanding Service Award from the Division of Infectious Diseases and Tropical Medicine; and

WHEREAS, believing that "*if a community has been good to you, in some respects, you have an obligation to give back to that community for the future generations,*" Dr. Goldman developed the BRIDGE Healthcare Clinic, a student-run free facility at the University of South Florida, supported scholarships to the USF College of Medicine throughout his career, and has been instrumental in raising funds for the USF Foundation; and

WHEREAS, currently serving as USF Professor, Department of Internal Medicine and Department of Environmental and Occupational Health, Associate Dean for Graduate Medical Education and Alumni Affairs, and Medical Director of the Physician Assistant Program, Dr. Goldman continues his stellar medical career, committed to providing the residents of our community with the highest quality health care, and teaching, preparing, and influencing generations of medical students, residents, fellows, and physicians now practicing medicine, sharing his wisdom, ethics, and compassion.
