WHEREAS, those individuals affected by cancer who receive psychosocial care can have improved quality of life and reduced distress, which enhances overall cancer care and survivorship; and

WHEREAS, the American Psychosocial Oncology Society (APOS), established in 1986, is the only multidisciplinary professional organization in the United States dedicated to the psychosocial aspects of cancer treatment; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the American Psychosocial Oncology Society is advancing the science and practice of psychosocial care for people affected by cancer and its vision is a nation without suffering from unmet psychosocial needs of cancer; and

WHEREAS, with the theme *Implementing Quality Care Standards for Psychosocial Oncology and Supportive Care*, the American Psychosocial Oncology Society will hold its 11th Annual Conference on February 13-15, 2014, at the Tampa Convention Center in Tampa, Florida, featuring guest presenters and workshops that will explore how to put into everyday practice the science-based standards that provide quality psychosocial cancer care.
