WHEREAS, CareFest® USA, founded in 2001, is a catalytic community service organization that inspires people to “*Bee Caretagious; Making Caring Contagious*” all year long; and

WHEREAS, CareFest® is a one day community service event with the goal of mobilizing local businesses, church communities, and social agencies to work together in meeting the needs Tampa Bay citizens, thereby improving neighborhoods and the quality of life for residents; and

WHEREAS, this 14th Annual CareFest® 2014 event, held on Saturday, September 27, 2014, will be hosted by the non-profit organization *Somebody Cares Tampa Bay* (SCTB), a network of independent, community-based agencies that provide outreach support to area faith-based ministries who assist poverty-stricken families and the working poor; and

WHEREAS, in collaboration with CareFest® USA and working with local ministries, Somebody Cares Tampa Bay’s mission is to provide the basic necessities of life, and to educate and develop healthy, self-sustaining communities, families and individuals; and

WHEREAS, the goal is achieved through projects that beautify homes and repair neighborhoods including painting, cleaning, roofing, plumbing, and landscaping and mulching, and last year work was completed with the help of nearly 4,500 volunteers on over 400 projects in 26 Tampa Bay area communities, 44 of the projects within the city of Tampa, with 500 volunteers participating.
