**WHEREAS**, the City of Tampa is proud to recognize organizations that have made an impact in our community through their dedicated outreach and support, and the United Negro College Fund (UNCF) is one such organization that has demonstrated and is committed to these actions; and

**WHEREAS**, UNCF has assisted minority students for over seven decades in reaching that all important goal of obtaining a higher education, providing more than \$3.6 billion to over 400,000 students since 1944; and

**WHEREAS**, each year, the organization awards 10,000 scholarships to students of low and moderate-income families to attend more than 900 schools across the nation, and also financially supports its 37 member historically black colleges and universities so these institutions will have the opportunity to provide additional scholarships that they would otherwise not be able to; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of their mission to support students' education and development, in addition to scholarship opportunities, UNCF has over 400 programs that they administer including internship and fellowship, mentoring, summer enrichment, and curriculum and faculty development programs; and

WHEREAS, one of these outreach efforts began 30 years ago by Dr. Sam Horton, a well-respected educator, and together with ten high schools in Hillsborough County, the All-Star Basketball Classic was inaugurated, which provides an opportunity for African-American students to showcase their skills to college recruiters, and this event has expanded over the years as the game of basketball has grown and number of high schools has tripled; and

**WHEREAS**, celebrating its 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, the All-Star Basketball Classic will take place at Jefferson High School in Tampa, Florida, and will feature boys' and girls' games, three-point shootouts, and slam dunk competitions, and all of the proceeds from this exciting and popular event will support the UNCF scholarship program.
