**WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority (ΔΣΘ), Incorporated** is an organization of college-educated women who perform public service initiatives, and has grown over the years to become the largest African-American Greek-lettered sorority in the world with alumnae and collegiate chapters located throughout the United States and around the world, including the Bahamas, Bermuda, England, Germany, Japan, the Republic of Korea and the Virgin Islands; and

**WHEREAS,** established in 1913 by twenty-two women on the Howard University Campus in Washington, D.C., the organization remains true to the Founders' vision of promoting academic excellence, providing scholarship assistance, supporting the underserved, educating and stimulating participation in the establishment of positive public policy, and highlighting issues and providing solutions to problems in their communities; and

**WHEREAS,** with its motto, *Uncompromising Commitment to Communities: Service, Leadership, Empowerment*, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority is faithfully committed to the *Five Point Programmatic Thrust* of Economic Development, Educational Development, International Awareness and Involvement, Physical and Mental Health, and Political Awareness and Involvement; and

**WHEREAS,** Delta Sigma Sorority began their commitment to service a over one-hundred years ago with their participation in the 1913 Women's Suffrage March on Washington, D.C., and remain active members in organizations such as the National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC), the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), and National Council of Negro Women (NCNW); and

**WHEREAS,** the members of the Tampa, Florida Chapters of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. are actively involved in the community, providing volunteer services, food and toys to needy families, and scholarships to deserving students, and as part of the national **Delta Days** program, they will visit the City of Tampa to bring their mission to local government and allow the opportunity for its members to interact with their elected officials to foster knowledge and understanding.
