WHEREAS, the City of Tampa, Florida takes great pride in recognizing the rich history of our community, and specifically Historic Ybor City, founded in 1886 by cigar manufacturers, and its significance as home to the cigar industry in America; and

WHEREAS, a pioneer of Tampa's cigar industry was the late Carlos Arturo Fuente, Sr. who assumed leadership of the Arturo Fuente Cigar Company from his father, and through his hard work, business sense and perseverance, grew the company from its 1912 home-based roots to one of the largest handmade cigar organizations in the world that include elite premium blends that are well-respected by cigar aficionados; and

WHEREAS, the neighborhoods of Ybor City were populated by thousands of immigrants, including those from Spain, Cuba and Italy, and these dedicated citizens would work in the cigar factories as highly skilled artisans rolling cigars, making cigar bands and cigar boxes, and by the early 1900's Tampa was known as the *Cigar Capital of the World* and the output by Tampa workers by 1929 exceeded 500,000,000 cigars; and

WHEREAS, the architectural styles of the historic buildings in Ybor City including cigar factories, housing for the workers called casitas, commercial sites, and ethnic clubs organized by the immigrants have created a unique landscape and ambience, and are representative of Tampa's cultural diversity brought to our community through the cigar industry; and

WHEREAS, in celebration of the rich history the immigrant families brought to Tampa over a century ago, the Ybor City Cigar Festival held on Saturday, November 19, 2016 at Centennial Park in the Historic District of Ybor City in Tampa, Florida with a Kick-Off Party the evening prior on Friday, November 18th at Davidoff Cigar Lounge; and

WHEREAS, presented by Arturo Fuente Cigar Company and J.C. Newman Cigar Company, hosted by Cigar City Magazine and supported by many generous sponsors, this festival brings together cigar and history enthusiasts, Ybor City supporters, families, and visitors who will have the opportunity to experience the finest hand-rolled premium cigars from Tampa and around the world, libations, traditional Tampa food and delicacies, cigar rolling demonstrations, the Fuente/Newman Cigar Lounge, entertainment featuring the Sol Caribe Latin Band and Vaya D.J., and more, and proceeds from the festival will benefit Volunteers of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Buckhorn, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the city of Tampa, Florida do hereby proclaim Saturday, November 19, 2016 as
