WHEREAS, the United States Merchant Marine has played a critical role in every major American military conflict since the American Revolution (1775-1783), transporting large amounts of war material, supplies, equipment and troops, and during World War II, they were vital to the war effort, contributing to the Allied victory; and

WHEREAS, the United States Merchant Marine suffered great casualties during World War II with more than 8,650 of the 215,000 Mariners killed and 3.1 tons of merchant ships lost, and the sacrifices that were made ensured our liberty and the American way of life; and

WHEREAS, founded in 1984, the American Merchant Marine Veterans (AMMV) is a non-profit Veterans national organization that includes a Florida charter, and its mission is in educating people about the vital role in which the United States Merchant Marine has played in the history of our nation, and seeks recognition for the sacrifices and contributions made by the men and women who have served, and continue to serve in times of peace and war; and

WHEREAS, the AMMV is hosting its 33rd Annual American Merchant Marine Veterans' National Convention and Reunion on March 21-24, 2019 at The Westshore Grand Hotel in Tampa, Florida, and the event features speakers, a dinner cruise, a special tour of the SS American Victory Ship, and keynote speaker Rita Crosby, Emmy Award Winner, Author, Television Host, News Reporter, and Veterans Advocate...
