WHEREAS, to celebrate the rich history and cultural diversity of West Tampa, the West Tampa CRA's (Community Redevelopment Agency) Community Advisory Committee is hosting the Second Annual Unity Tampa Historical and Cultural Festival on Sunday, September 29, 2019 at Julian B. Lane Riverfront Park, and the free event celebrates the history and culture of West Tampa, and it includes special tributes to members of the community who have made a significant difference, Dr. Walter L. Smith is a West Tampa native well-known for his vast accomplishments and impact in higher education, at home and internationally, including as Provost of Hillsborough Community College, President of Roxbury Community College in Massachusetts, as seventh President of Florida A&M University (FAMU), he was the Founding Rector of Funda Community College in South Africa, he is a nationally recognized expert on American community colleges, the author of *The Magnificent Twelve: Florida's Black Junior Colleges* (1994), and he developed the Dr. Walter L. Smith Library in his beloved West Tampa Community; and

WHEREAS, *Mrs. Ruth McNair*, is a trailblazer dedicated to ensuring the West Tampa community receives vital services, safety measures, assistance and equality with the goal of maintaining and improving the historic neighborhood, and her contributions include serving as President of the West Riverfront Crime Watch Group for almost three decades, involvement with organizations such as the Tampa Homeowners Association of Neighborhoods, the CDC's Economic Development Plan, the West Tampa Overlay Plan, and many others, and she has worked tirelessly with the City of Tampa, Tampa City Council, and Hillsborough County Commissioners attending and participating in pertinent meetings, and through her efforts, commitment, determination and love for her community, West Tampa is a vibrant neighborhood with an enhanced quality of life for its residents.
