For such a purpose, they may need to hire a court reporter to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

- Links Downtown Tampa to Palmetto Beach, Ybor City, Rowlett Park, Sulphur Springs, Lowry Park, and along the Hillsborough River back to Downtown Tampa
- Connects neighborhoods, parks, and schools along connection



What is Segment D?


- Provides traffic calming and bicycle and pedestrian improvements
- Bicycle Boulevard markings on:
 - Park Dr.
 - Park Cir.
 - 12th St.
 - Patterson St.
 - Hamilton Health Dr.
 - Van Dyke Pl
 - Hollywood St.
- 6-ft sidewalk east side of Van Dyke Pl from Hamilton Heath Dr. to Hollywood St.







Typical Section 1 – w/ sidewalk






Typical Section 2 – w/ speed cushions Tampa






Typical Section 3 – w/ resurfacing








Nebraska Ave. to Hamilton Heath Dr. and Nebraska Ave. to E. Patterson St.






Hamilton Heath Dr. & E. Patterson St. to E. Park Cir.












Speed Cushions designed for Segment D

> Example of a Speed Cushion








Speed Cushion Details










Where are we now?

- Segment D is in design (Complete 2022)
- Segment E design has been finalized
- Entire Green ARTery was programmed in FY2020
 - \$1M for Design; \$6.5M for Const. (FY 2020 estimate, certainly gone up since then)
 - With the Supreme Court's decision, the original 2018 Surtax is no longer available as a funding source
- We can continue to seek funding for segments and follow up with a comprehensive way-finding network
 - This approach takes time
- Meanwhile, we will focus our efforts on developing safe crossings with our own projects as well as our agency partners.
