#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Green ARTery Perimeter Trail will be a 22-mile trail that connects Tampa's Urban Core through parks and greenspaces by utilizing existing neighborhood roads and park trails. This neighborhood-based effort seeks to identify and enhance the beauty of the City's existing assets while continuing to build upon that beauty.

Segment D (1.376 miles) will complete the following:

- Bicycle Blvd markings on Park Dr, Park Cir, 12th St, Patterson St, Hamilton Heath Drive, Van Dyke Pl and Hollywood St.
- Share-the Road markings on Nebraska Ave from Hollywood Dr to Sitka St
- New 5-foot-wide sidewalk on the east side of Van Dyke PI from Hamilton Heath Dr to the Hillsborough River.

## **BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY**

The trail will encourage walking and cycling while providing an alternative to traveling by car throughout Tampa's Urban Core. Additionally, it will make travel safer for all users of the roadway in accordance with the City's Vision Zero initiative.
