

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The current layout at Interbay Blvd at Tanker Way includes a single eastbound right-turn lane onto Tanker Way and an access point for MacDill Air Force Base. The vehicles entering MacDill Air Force Base pass through a checkpoint before entrance is permitted onto the base, which creates a queue that blocks the thru lanes on Interbay Blvd. This project proposes the following improvements:

- Additional right-turn lane and realignment of the through lanes between Manhattan Ave and Tanker Way.
- Resurfacing and installation of new sidewalks.

The project has received funding through a 2020 Defense Infrastructure Grant (DIG) worth \$340,000.

BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY

- Improves intersection safety for all road users
- Reduces congestion and traffic delays with the additional right-turn lane to increase queue capacity, resulting in reduced congestion on Interbay Blvd.
- Improves sidewalk connectivity.
- Improves roadway condition by resurfacing the roadway within the project limits.
