



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## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

This project is evaluating improvements for the West Riverside Heights Neighborhood to create a safe, attractive, and livable communities as part of the City's holistic approach to local road maintenance. The City started with a "Listen First" approach by engaging the community to learn about their concerns and to identify potential improvements to improve safety and reflect the neighborhoods values.

The City will take advantage of the planned neighborhood resurfacing to implement other features to slow vehicle speeds, improve safety and support multimodal options in the neighborhood.

#### BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY

- Improved roadway condition The project will resurface all roadways within the neighborhood.
- Improved mobility The project proposes adding a sidewalk along N River View Ave from Woodlawn Ave to MLK.
- Increased safety The project will implement traffic calming measures like chicanes, curb extensions, speed tables, and splitter islands along select corridors that have been identified through the City's meetings with residents of the neighborhood.
- Reduce cut-through traffic The City will install staggered all-way stops and neighborhood gateway features to reduce cut-through traffic.
